

Description of the The Digs at Shenandoah West

This retreat is off dirt roads in the middle of nowhere; it is rustic, with no frills - as in not very fancy. If you like camping, you'll like this setting, but if you prefer fancy hotels, you may want to consider staying in town. Cell phone reception can be spotty here.

Wildlife, Children and Dogs

Wildlife in the area includes many deer, squirrels, gophers, skunks, snakes, birds, coyotes, possible mountain lions and bob cats. For this reason it is important that children are closely supervised and dogs are on leash at all times. Surrounding this wilderness are farms that if your dog is caught chasing livestock the farmers will shoot to kill. That is just country policy, so please do not let your dog run off leash.

Other Aspects

Because of the high fire danger we require a strict adherence to no smoking on the property and no open fires. BBQ in designated areas is OK. August is a very dry time of year. We expect the pond to be dry. Please bring clothes that can be comfortable in the heat and squirt guns. We'll have sprinklers to cool off with, so a swim suit is a good plan as well. There are some cool areas to relax in outside under the shade trees, and there are often pleasant breezes, but there is no air conditioning other than fans.

RV Information

This is not an RV park, but there are water and electrical hookups for up to eight RVs. However, there is no dumping for RV toilets. You can use the lodge toilets or dump at other locations. There is also a very nice RV park close by in Plymouth if you would rather stay there.

Driving Directions to Shenandoah Retreat

Take I-580 E toward HAYWARD/STOCKTON.

Keep LEFT to take I-205 E toward TRACY/STOCKTON.

Merge onto I-5 N.

Take EXIT 472 toward DOWNTOWN STOCKTON/CA-4 E/FRESNO AVENUE.

Merge onto CA-4 E toward DOWNTOWN STOCKTON/CA-99 E.

Take the CA-99 N exit on the LEFT toward SACRAMENTO.

Merge onto CA-99 N.

Take the WATERLOO RD EAST/CA-88 exit toward JACKSON.

Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto WATERLOO RD/CA-88. Continue to follow CA-88.

Turn LEFT to stay on CA-88. (towards Ion)

Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto CA-124. (into Ion)

Turn LEFT onto W MAIN ST, one block, /CA-104/CA-124.

Turn RIGHT onto PRESTON AVE/CA-104/CA-124.

Turn RIGHT onto PLYMOUTH HWY/CA-124. Continue to follow CA-124.

Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto CA-16. (towards Plymouth)

CA-16 becomes CA-49.

Turn RIGHT onto SHENANDOAH RD/CR-E16.

Continue to follow CR-E16. through River Pines (10.5)

Turn RIGHT onto OMO RANCH RD. Go 2.4 miles to Shenandoah Lane

Turn LEFT onto SHENANDOAH LN (Portions unpaved).
